



INNOVATION AWARDS

THE HISAKO TERASAKI YOUNG INNOVATOR AWARD

The Hisako Terasaki Young Innovator Award is intended to identify individuals who, early in their career, have contributed significantly to the field of biomedical science and show substantial promise of continued meritorious academic accomplishments in the field and of translating potentially high-impact innovations. This award is aimed to acknowledge novel breakthrough biomedical technologies as well as the potential for devices that are significant improvements over state-of-the-art technologies.

The Award:

- \$5,000
- Meeting registration
- The opportunity to orally present, in poster format, the research for which the award was given during the Terasaki Innovation Summit 2025.
- Oral Presentation at TIS 2025

Criteria for Nominees:

- All applications must be self-nominations
- Must plan to attend the Terasaki Innovation Summit 2025 and required to give an oral presentation.
- Be fewer than ten years past receipt of their highest academic degree

- CV and statements should include details of the context surrounding the candidate's contribution
- Those with post-degree clinical training (e.g. internship or residency) must be fewer than ten years past completion of their clinical training

How to Apply:

Applications must include:

- 500-1000 word statement for the applicant
- The abstract submission to be considered
- One single referee letter, this can have multiple signatures
- An updated curriculum vitae (PDF format required)
 - Include detail of involvement in mentoring of an/or support of the furthering of others' activities and careers, leadership potential, and teamwork
- Reprints of 2-6 publications of the work for which the nomination is being made
- Awardee will be notified by Early January 2025.
